CMTI over the last Six decades has developed Special Purpose Machines, Inspection Systems, Test Rigs for Qualification testing of products, Tooling, complex machined parts for public and private sectors. Current areas of focus of the Institute are Nanotechnology, Precision engineering, Metrology (Micro and Nano), Additive Manufacturing, Mechatronics, Vision and Image processing, Digital Design, Product Lifecycle Management (PLM), Smart Manufacturing and Human Resource Development.

CMTI invites applications from eligible candidates for Graduate (Engg./ Tech.)and Technician (Diploma) Apprenticeship training, through web portal www.mhrdnats.gov.in for the following disciplines of Engineering/ Technology, under the Apprenticeship act 1961 and Apprenticeship rules 1992 (as amended from time to time), for the year 2021 – 22, for a period of **01 year**.

* After completion of 6 months of Apprenticeship training, their performance will be reviewed, and based on the satisfactory performance, apprentices will be paid enhanced stipend

Eligibility:

Candidates who have successfully passed the qualifying Degree/ Diploma during/ after 2019 having secured minimum of **First Class*** in qualifying exam and

- ✚ Not taken any training as part of apprenticeship programme
- ✚ Not completed post-graduation in Engineering (e.g. M.E/ M.Tech/ MBA)
- ✚ Not have any work experience of one year or more
- ✚ Shall have standard of fitness as prescribed in the clause 4/ Schedule II of Apprenticeship Rules 1992, and amendments thereof, if any.

Note: * - First class means 60% marks aggregates of all semesters in the qualifying examination. In case of Universities / Institutes awarding CGPA / SGPA grading etc., the candidates are requested to convert the same into percentage based on the formula as per their respective Universities / Institutes rules. The percentage will be considered after conversion.

General Instructions for Candidates:

1. Candidates have to enrol themselves online in the National Web Portal www.mhrdnats.gov.in by providing required details and uploading the required documents to get User Id & Password.

For enrolment Candidates should have a valid email id, contact mobile number, Govt. ID (any one of Driving License, Voter ID, Passport or PAN card) , Aadhaar Card, Passport Size photograph (.jpeg file format and size of it less than 200kB), Aadhaar linked bank account details.

2. After successful enrolment, the Candidates will be provided with a **student enrolment number** by NATS/MHRD.
3. Web portal is being operated by MHRD, Government of India. For enquiries regarding the issues related with web portal, the candidates are requested to contact help line numbers mentioned in the web portal. Correspondence with respect to functionality of portal will not be entertained by CMTI.
4. Indian Nationals only need to apply.
5. The Institute reserves the right to adopt its own method of short-listing criteria.
6. Any amendments/updates and list of the shortlisted/ selected candidates will be hosted in our website www.cmti.res.in only. Candidates are requested to visit the website for the same regularly.
7. No correspondence or enquiries will be entertained from the candidates about the Apprenticeship.
8. Canvassing in any form will be treated as disqualification.
9. No TA/DA will be paid to applicants for attending document verification/ selection/ joining process. Candidates will have to make their own arrangement for stay, if required, during this process.
10. The selected candidates should be in a position to join the establishment on the prescribed date of joining. If the candidate does not report latest by scheduled date, it is assumed that he/she is not interested in the apprenticeship and his/her candidature will be forfeited.
11. Selected Apprentices can join CMTI as Apprentices only after getting approval from the Board of Apprenticeship Training (BOAT).
12. The selected candidates must execute a contract for the period of training of 1 year as per the Apprenticeship Act. Engaging suitable candidates as Apprentices or the completion of training at CMTI shall not entitle such apprentices/trainees, any right to claim any type of employment in CMTI.
13. Mere fulfilment of requirements as laid down in the advertisement does not qualify a candidate to be selected Graduate / Technician (Diploma) Apprentice.
14. CMTI shall not be responsible for any application being rejected or candidate not shortlisted due to incorrect data.
15. CMTI reserves the right to cancel the advertisement and or the selection process there under. Decision of CMTI Management regarding the selection will be final. Further CMTI Management reserves the full right to fill up or otherwise any or all the notified posts depending on the availability of the candidates in any discipline and also to fill up the vacancies if any.
16. If at any stage of training, it is found that the candidate has furnished false/incorrect information or concealed any information, his/her Training shall be cancelled and suitable action will be taken as per extant rules. CMTI reserves the right to Revise/ Reschedule/ Cancel/ Suspend the engagement process, if the need so arises, without assigning any further notice or reason therefore. The decision of the management shall be final and no appeal shall be entertained.
17. Interested & eligible Candidates should register their names and bring all their **original certificates / mark sheets, Govt. ID proof, Aadhaar, Bank passbook (Aadhaar linked account), Valid Caste Certificate** (should be in Central Government Format) with a **self-attested photo copy of each of it** and a recent passport size **photograph** along with the **duly filled Application Form** between **9:00 to 10:00Hrs** on the respective days, failing which they would not be allowed to appear for the selection process/ interview.
